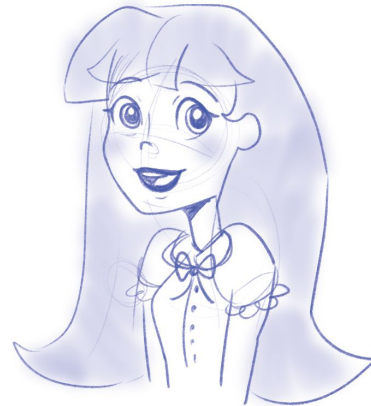


CCS Western Art Club: Character Design Edition

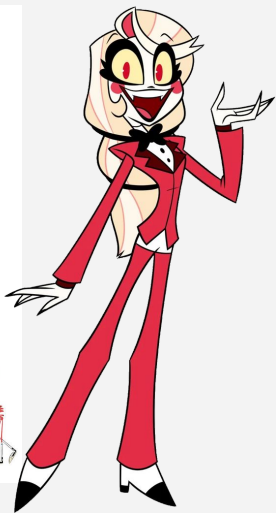
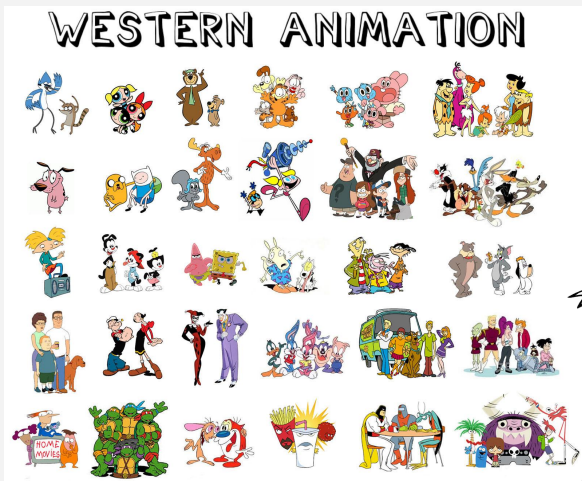

Purpose of this Class:

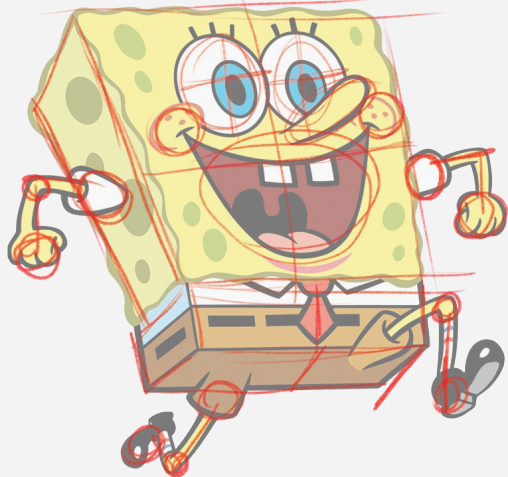
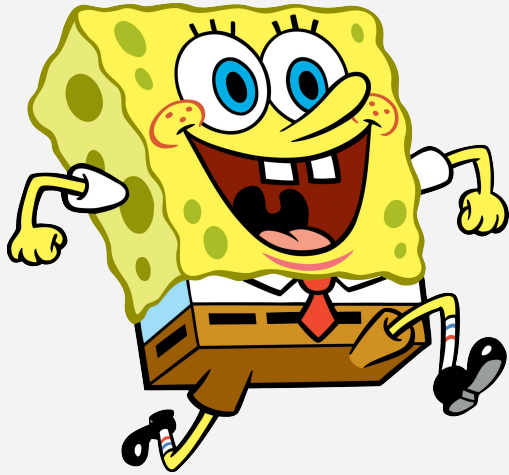
- Artists and cartoon enthusiasts unite to learn about all sorts of art styles in Western animation such as Disney, Cartoon Network, Nickelodeon and internet media of all kinds! This also includes popular graphic novels and fictional books like *Diary of a Wimpy Kid*, *Dog Man*, *Babysitters Club*, etc.
- We will be focusing on character design.
- Students will hone in their technical art skills and craft while sharing their common interests in western media.
- This will bring together a tight-knit community of students who will develop confidence in self expression.



What are the fundamentals?

These skills are the building blocks of in character design. Advanced skills exist, but we will cover the **absolute basics**. Even after this class ends, artists will recall these skills which will help them have an better understanding on how to approach a problem with creative solutions:

- Proportions
- Clothing
- Eyes/facial expressions/the face in general
- Shapes/Character skeleton
- Shapes like drawing different shaped heads
- Poses
- Basic Color Theory
- Faces
- Animals (brief)
- Props (Swords, wands, etc.)
- Drawing from life



- This is not a “How to draw your favorite cartoon character course”. This course focuses on the fundamentals of character design specifically in the style of western media
- Objectivity and technique = main focus
 - Art supplies will be included
- Active participation will improve your artwork! These skills are not done overnight! They require time, effort, and a ton of patience!
- Students will not be able to fully master the fundamentals towards the end of the course, but they will have knowledge and have more confidence in their artistic skills.
