2. Read-A-thon

- c. Will have a vendor to track spending
- d. PFC will offer prizes this year. Class prizes for the top fundraising class for each grade level. Will also do a gift card for the class library
- e. Top 2 earners for each grade level will get a prize as well
- f. CCS parent asked if there will be a theme for Read-A-Thon. CCS PFC responded no them at this time
- g. Goal for Read-A-Thon is \$10,000
- 3. 8th Grade Promotion
 - a. Planning process has started for next week
 - b. Flyers will be sent out
 - c. Promotion will be on Thursday June 2nd 8:45 a.m. Only 2 guests per student are allowed. All visitors must complete the volunteer form and complete covid testing procedures.

Budget -

- 1. PFC treasurer went over CCS quarterly budget review
 - a. Income all the way there; short about \$4,000 bulk will come back once we start with the Spring Fundraiser. Gap should be close by end of March when Read-A-Thon is completed
 - b. Enrichment- budgeted \$35,000 in which \$19,000 was spent so far.
 - c. Gift to school/Grade level funding- Bulk of the Gift to school is from classroom

stipends about ~40% on the way there

- i. Reminders to teachers to use the funds before the end of this school year as the funds do not roll over
- ii. Grade level funding- Just under 17-20% there. Grade level leads mentioned there are proposed plans.
- iii. Reminder budget numbers are always posted on PFC website

SSC Updates -

- 1. Mrs. VanLare went of the K-8 vision committee updates
 - a. CCS will stay K-8 school
 - b. CCS is working closely with SSC and other groups to decide what qualities we want to embrace as a school
 - c. Trying to build the staff cohesiveness through this committee and create long term objectives.
 - d. Putting systems in place to be more cohesive and to make sure we are really working together as a K-8 school
 - e. Examining behavior system. There's an elementary and secondary handbook. Will come up with a K-8 handbook for next school year. Goal is for behavior expectations to be clear for all students and all grade levels.
 - A system is in place already to track minor behavior infractions in which this is more highlighted
 - ii. A system is also in place for major behavior infractions as well.
 - f. Character assemblies are going well (this month is Trustworthiness)
- 2. SSC Representative added that they are already planning for next school year.
 - a. Goals set up for students
 - b. Enrollment numbers projected
 - c. SSC re-elections; slots are open. Link for questions and interest are in the principal's weekly and will remain there until elections
