There is a \$14K shortage in predicted budget of \$60K, that means the board members are looking into cutting some of the enrichment programs and facility upgrades funds. There is a need for a spring Fundraiser to cover the facility upgrades that have been planned. The Fun Run committee is in full preparation for the upcoming event that is planned on Oct 6th. The event will take place in Fallon Sports park at the baseball field. In order to provide safety for students during the event, the PFC is looking for a large amount of volunteers.
